What is Trivia Night?

It is THE WPPS event of the year! This event is the P&C's major fundraising initiative. We aim to raise over \$15,000 on this night through ticket sales, auctions, donations and sponsorship.

Trivia Night is held in the WPPS school hall. Our MC this year is Russell Barwick who is a former Austereo Sports Director, ESPN Sports host and correspondent, TVN host, commentator and executive producer. Russell has very generously donated his time to MC our event.

When is it?

Friday 16th of June, 2017.

We kick off at 7pm and the night usually ends by 11.30pm.

What is the Trivia Night's theme in 2017?

Each year we have a different theme and all guests dress up to bring the theme to life. This year our theme is 'Made in America' so come dressed in your most American inspired costume. Think anything American – TV, Movies, Politics, Products, History, Comedians, Sporting teams... anything goes!!

For any WPPS newbies, the costume element to Trivia night is serious business! Be sure to dress up on the night as best costume will win a prize.

How much are the tickets?

Early bird offer (purchased before 9 th June):	\$35 per person
General tickets (purchased after 9 th of June):	\$40 per person
Tickets purchased at the door on the night of the event:	\$50 per person

How many people per table?

Tables are in groups of 8 or 10 people. So get your friends together and make a group. Tables are not allocated before the evening so when you and your friends arrive grab a table and set up.

Who can attend?

Families of WPPS students. You must be over 18 years old.

I'd love to go but I don't have a table to join, what should I do?

Speak to your friendly P&C Committee and they will help find you a table to join. If you do not know who your P&C Committee is ask your Class Parent for help.

Can I buy food and drink on the night?

This event is BYO food and alcohol. There is no catering provided on the night so please bring your own food and drinks.
